**May Devotions**



**The month of may is a very special  
month dedicated to the Blessed  
Virgin Mary. To honor the Blessed  
Virgin Mary, we will pray the Holy Rosary before  
every mass for the entire month of May.**

**Reflection:** Today's Gospel passage tells us about the importance of the Old Testament in understanding the Christ-event. Jesus helped the two disciples to look at the events connected to life of Jesus in the light of the prophecies of the Old Testament. That enlightened the mind of the disciples. Their hearts were burning within them when they listened to Jesus. Yet to believe in the resurrection, they needed assistance from above. That assistance came through when Jesus broke the bread for them. When "he took the bread and blesses and broke it and gave it to them", their eyes were opened and they recognized him". At the Eucharistic table we should be able to recognize him as our Lord and Master who gives himself to us.
