The CWL asks YOU to Support Conscience Rights in Canada



The Euthanasia Prevention Coalition has already helped secure protection of conscience rights for healthcare professionals in Manitoba, and wants to do the same for all Canadians. The Coalition of Health CARE and Conscience members sent 14,000 letters to the government of Manitoba leading to the Medical Assistance in Dying (Protection for Health Professionals and Others) Act passed in November 2017. The legislation also protects doctors, nurses, pharmacists and other health professionals in that province.

Other caregivers, like those in Ontario, are not so fortunate. There are still 9 other provinces and three territories who don't have this protection. The Coalition needs funding to expand our "Call for Conscience Campaigns" across Canada. This year we have targeted Saskatchewan, Ontario, and Nova Scotia. But we can't do it without your help. We need \$50,000 to protect caregivers who cannot participate in taking their patient's lives. Saturday, May 4th is "24 Hours of Prayer for Palliative Care Day" in Ontario. Please pray the following in support of this important cause: We pray today for all health care professionals. That they may be able to care for their patients in palliative care with courage and compassion. We pray that they are able to continue their important work without the fear of having to go against their beliefs regarding the sanctity of life. Lord hear our prayer.

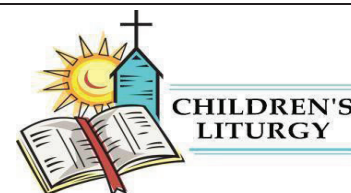
