Dina Belanger was born of Olivier Octave Belanger and Seraphia Matte on April 30th 1897, baptized in St. Roch, Quebec and lived on 168 Notre Dame des Anges. She showed a great talent in her early years for music, studied in New York for two years qualifying as a music teacher. While studying she lived with the Religious of Jesus and Mary, returned home, entered the religious life at the congregation in Sillery and took her vows in 1923. In spirit of praise and generosity she was able to "refuse God nothing" and despite illness continued to teach music. Dina became a model for musician, artists and educators, she died in 1929 and promised to be a "beggar of love in heaven;" Dina was beatified on March 20th 1993.
