Easter reminds us that God deeply loves us. He is our hope and strength not just for this season... but everyday. Happy Easter!



You can easily obtain the forms, they are located at the entrances of the church or by contacting the parish office. You can change the amount of your donation or withdraw from this program at any time. Here are some of the benefits of the PADP:



- Your contributions will be made regularly even if you are away on business or vacation.
- You will not have to write a cheque or carry cash each week when you come to church, possibly saving you bank service fees.



Our church will receive your contributions consistently,

which will help pay all the bills even in the summer months when many are away.

- After having been away, you will not be left with that burden of feeling you need to "catch up"
- It will save time and work for those who count and register the offerings each Monday.
