The Sudbury Right to Life Committee is preparing for the 21st National March for Life which will be held on Parliament Hill in Ottawa on Thursday, May 10th, 2018. Two chartered buses (coaches) from Sudbury have been reserved. We will leave in the morning at 6 am and return to Sudbury the same night at approximately 9:30 pm.

One bus will leave from the parking lot of Ste. Anne des Pins Parish and the other from Tim Hortons in Val Caron. A stop for more passengers is planned in Sturgeon Falls (7 a.m.) and another in North Bay (around 7:30 a.m.). Everyone must bring a lunch for both meals; a restroom stop is planned near Pembroke.
