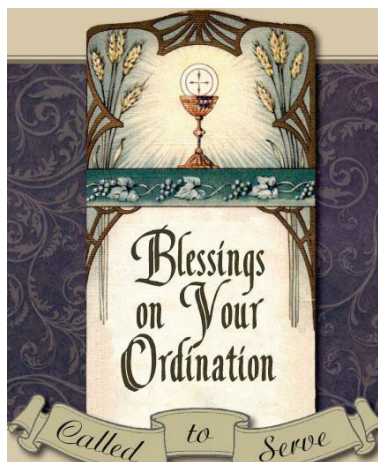

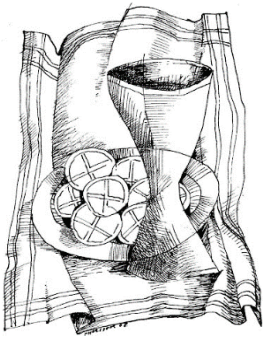

Pandemic Recipe Share Space ...

M.J.'s Cinnamon Rolls (easy, delicious, and ... no yeast 😊)

4 cups flour

6 tsp. baking powder

2 tsp. salt

2 heaping tbsp. sugar

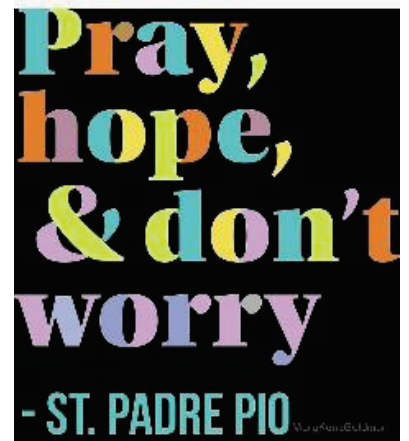
~♥~Mix the above ingredients together (with your hands). Add ½ cup of butter or shortening (room temperature). Blend into flour with hand until crumbly (mealy). Make a well in the center of the bowl and add 2 cups of milk. With a fork, scrape all the flour into the milk and combine until all of the flour is absorbed and you have the dough nicely combined. Sprinkle a little flour on your counter and form ball of batter and place on floured surface.

Sprinkle flour on dough and rolling pin and roll the dough until ½ inch of thickness. You can use butter or margarine and spread all over the dough – just like spreading peanut butter on the top of a slice of bread. Now sprinkle with brown sugar, more than a cup, right to the edges. Now sprinkle cinnamon over the surface – don't be shy. Roll the dough up like a jelly roll. With a serrated bread knife cut off both ends of the roll.

Cut slices about ¾ inch thick and place on end on a cookie sheet (lined with parchment paper). You'll make about 15 cinnamon rolls. Bake on middle rack at 425° (350° if you are using a metal pan). Bake for 18 minutes, but check often throughout, you are looking for a nice golden top. Yummy with or without the frosting.

Frosting: 3 tbsp butter, 2 tsp. vanilla, 2 c. icing sugar and a bit of milk. Stir and if it's too thick add a bit more milk. Spread over warm cinnamon rolls ... **Enjoy!**
