



**Reflection**: In today's Gospel reading Jesus asks His disciples two questions. The first is, "Who do people say I am?" The answers given by the disciples are all variations of one answer, "Jesus is a great prophet." Jesus' second question to his disciples is

"Who do you say I am?" Peter speaks for the other disciples, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." Here indeed is a real insight into Jesus' identity; He acknowledges Peter's insight, "Blessed are you, Simon." But He immediately declares that this insight is a God-given insight; it is not simply the result of Peter's own natural abilities, "It was not flesh and blood that revealed this to you, but my Father in heaven." What is true of Peter, in this regard, is true of all of us. If any of us is to come to know Jesus more fully, it is only with God's help that we can do this; we need the light of God's spirit if we are to come to know God's Son. It is above all the Spirit who leads us to the truth, who leads us to the One who said "I am the way, the truth, and the life." 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2023.'


## **Act of Spiritual Communion Prayer**


