**Saint's Corner** ... Blessed Frédéric Janssoone, was born in 1856 to a farming family in Flanders, Northern France. He was the thirteenth child of the family and left school to help his widowed mother. After her death, he continued his schooling and joined the Franciscans. He was sent to the Holy Land, came to Canada on a fundraising campaign, and several years later, due to his gifts of preaching, skills in fundraising and diplomacy, settled in our country. He was instrumental in establishing the Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Rosary near Cap-dela-Madeleine; he died on August 4th 1916, is buried in the Franciscan Chapel in Trois-Rivieres, and was beatified in 1988.

**World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation** ... In 2015, Pope Francis declared September 1 as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. Coinciding with a celebration instituted by the Orthodox Church, it is also a day of ecumenical prayer and unity (ORDO: page 329).
