

## Fourth Week of Advent

## Fourth Sunday in Advent

"...an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. (Matthew 1:18-24) How special a man is Saint Joseph! Although he is sometimes found in the shadowy background of stable scenes (or not portrayed at all), today's gospel reveals much about the level of his essential spiritual awareness and unwavering trust in God. As we know through many other examples in scripture, dreams are one way in which God guides us. For Joseph to not only take a dream seriously, but to act on it by reversing the direction of his own plans, gives us insight into how Jesus must have been influenced by Joseph's selflessness, obedience and humility. The sort of man Jesus became, a man of the Beatitudes, reflects Joseph; the sort of woman Mary became also reflects Joseph. Without Joseph's change of mind, without Joseph's faith, without Joseph's commitment and protection, the first Christmas would have been quite different. It might never have happened. (Lucinda M.
