<u>A Saint's Corner</u> - A Canadian Jesuit, *Fr. Martin Royackers* from SW Ontario was gunned down in 2001 in front of his church in Jamaica, the reason his defence and support of the poor in the darkness of injustice and uncontrolled violence. In 2010 in Burundi, Africa a clinic [Yezu Mwiza/Sweet Jesus] for Aids/HIV patients was dedicated in his name, the second one in memory of Fr. Martin and his work among the sick, poor and marginalized; the funds for the clinic came from Canada, the Dutch Jesuits and his family and an annual lecture series in his name was established at



Regis College in Toronto. His passion for framing and justice made him a natural candidate for Jamaica and in the prime time of his life, at 41, he was murdered while preaching and living Jesus' example. Father Martin is buried near Montego Bay at the Parish of St. Theresa.
