Reflection How beautiful to end the year with the feast of the Holy Family. What joy to live in a happy family! In St. Augustine’s words, “This joy is marvellously inexpressible and inexpressibly marvellous.” The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph is happy despite their fair share of trials and troubles. They flee to Egypt, for Herold seeks to kill the Child. The twelve-year-old Jesus gets lost on the pilgrimage to Jerusalem. Imagine the agony of Joseph and Mary go through as they look for Him for three days. Later, Joseph dies, leaving Mary and Jesus in grief. Jesus Himself is killed in the prime of life. Despite all this, theirs is a happy family. What is the secret of happiness. Manifestly, their life is centered on God. We need to pray as a family. The family that prays together stays together. Prayer must be accompanied by a spirit of work. Each member of the family needs to do his or her bit. Like parts of the body working together, we ought to help one another. 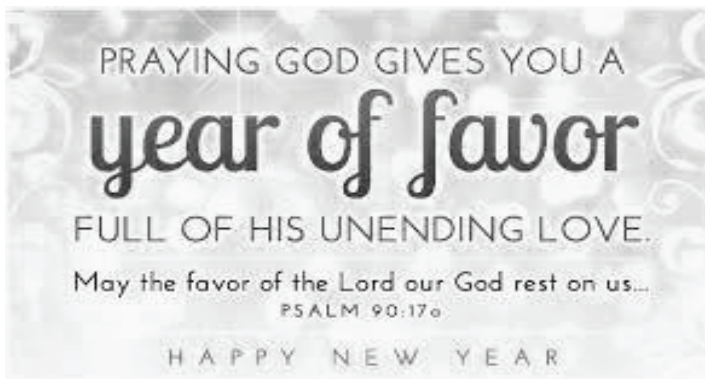
