## **Discovering Christ Winter 2020**

**Discovering Christ** is a program for those who wish to hear the Good News and personally encounter Jesus Christ. All sessions and the retreat will be at St. Patrick's Church. Each session includes 4 components: shared light meal, welcome and prayer, video presentation and small group discussion. The meal



consists of soup, beverages and dessert. You are welcome to bring a 'brown-bag'. Menus will be provided in advance. We will begin the evening at 6:00 pm. The evening will conclude at 8:30 pm. The retreat day (light meal & snacks included) is from 9:00 am-3:00 pm. We ask that you commit to attending all 7 sessions and the retreat. We suggest a donation of \$5.00 per session to defray costs.
