COUNTDOWN TO LENT

Ash Wednesday is coming! Lent begins on February 18th. *Lent is a time to prepare for Easter by observing a period of fasting, repentance, moderation and spiritual discipline. The purpose is to set aside time for reflection on Jesus Christ ~ his suffering and his sacrifice.*

Shrove Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday, is the beginning of Lent in the Roman Catholic Church. "Shrove" is the past tense of the word "shrive," which means to hear a confession, assign penance, and absolve from sin. Shrove Tuesday is a reminder that we are entering a season of penance. Shrove Tuesday is also known as Mardi Gras (which is simply French for Fat Tuesday). *Did you know...*
