

Stations of the Cross—Did You Know?



Praying the Stations of the Cross-alone or with a group-is a Lenten tradition. Read and pray these stations very slowly. Imagine the scene in Jerusalem as Jesus walked his Way of the Cross. Often, the Stations of the Cross is an action prayer. Catholics walk to the fourteen stations of the Way of the Cross and stop to pray at each of one. The traditional 14 Stations of the Cross are:

- 1) Jesus is condemned to death
- 2) Jesus accepts the cross
- 3) Jesus falls the first time
- 4) Jesus meets His Mother
- 5) Simon of Cyrene carries the cross
- 6) Veronica wipes the face of Jesus
- 7) Jesus falls the second time

- 8) Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem
- 9) Jesus falls the third time
- 10) Jesus is stripped of His garments
- 11) Crucifixion: Jesus is nailed to the cross
- 12) Jesus dies on the cross
- 13) Jesus' body is removed from the cross
- 14) Jesus is laid in the tomb and covered in incense


