Today is the First Sunday in Lent. This is a special time of prayer, fasting, giving and spiritual preparation. With our children spend extra time in prayer remembering Jesus's sacrifice for us.

**Reflection:** At the time of Noah, the Lord God unleashed the flood on the world as a result of the sins of men. Today, God makes a covenant with Noah, signified by the Rainbow, never again to destroy all things of flesh. To assuage the wrath of God against the sins of men, God sent His son Jesus to be the expiation for the punishment that is due to our sins. As we see from the experience of Jesus, temptation to sin is a reality of our lives.
