After Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law, many other sick people came to Him. Jesus healed these people and then He went away to pray. Whether to thank God, or ask for a

favour, or a blessing or to ask questions, prayer is an important part of Christian life. *Pray each morning, evening, at meal times and anytime in between with our children.*

Reflection: "Praise the Lod who heals the broken-hearted" This is the thought that resonated through all the readings today. While sickness suffering and pain are part of the human condition on earth, they are not necessarily signs that God loves us less or is punishing us for our sins. Such deliberating conditions can very often test our faith in God and lead us to despair

as we saw in the case of Job. Sometimes, God may allow us to endure sickness, suffering and pain in order to test our faith, humble us and bring us back to Him. In the Gospel, Jesus restored to health all those who were afflicted with various kinds of diseases, including Simon's mother-in law. In the midst of all that we may sometimes have to suffer in life, we must learn to turn to God who heals the broken-hearted.
