A Saint's Corner... Venerable Jerome Le Royer de la Dauversiere, born in Fleche France, 1597, raised in a devout family of minor nobility. In 1621, Jerome married, they had five children and he was known as devout and active in various charities and consecrated his family to the Holy Family. He followed an interior call to found a community of Sisters under Saint Joseph to serve the sick and poor; years later in 1631 he felt a call again to establish a community but this time in New France. When a settlement [Montreal] was established in 1642, three Sisters of the Hospitallers of St. Joseph arrived there in 1659 to operate a hospital; Jerome died only months later and declared venerable in 2007.
