A Saint's Corner. A little more Christmas spirit with *Silent Night, Holy Night* and *T'was the Moon of Winter Time* known as the Huron Carol. The former was first sang at Christmas Eve between the Mountains in Austria in 1818 and was over time translated into many languages with some changes; the Huron Carol was written about 175 years earlier not far south from Sudbury by a Jesuit priest, Saint Jean de Brebeuf, based on a French melody, with words spoken by the Aboriginal population and now sang in an English translation in our



parish. Some people see a true Canadian hymn in the history of that carol and maybe there can be a new translation in the Spirit of Reconciliation for our Nation and Church.
