### SAINTS' CORNER

**Saint André Bessette (1845-1937)**, is simply known as Brother André to visitors to Saint Joseph's Oratory, Montréal, PQ. Orphaned, with little education, he joined the Congregation of the Holy Cross. In 1904, with friends and supporters, a chapel was built at the site of a statue of Saint Joseph which is now the Oratory and final destination for millions of pilgrims every year. Brother André lived to a ripe old age of 91 and his Feast day is January 7<sup>th</sup>. For a life time, he confessed a deep love for Saint Joseph, prayed with and for the sick and troubled, and in doing so, gained great heavenly favours for many visitors.
