Reflection: Today's readings present a call with the same urgency as a drowning person yelling, "Help!" We are called to transform ourselves according to the mind of God. The Church encourages us to re-examine our ways in order to avoid the imminent wrath of God and enjoy His mercy. In the first reading, God proved Himself as a merciful father when He forgave the Ninevites their sins after they repented. If the Ninevites could repent from their evil and wicked ways, why not us? We live in a world that is so infiltrated with evil, wickedness, hatred, jealousy, killing, immorality, etc. These vices are persisting and increasing daily in our society. In the second reading, Saint Paul tells us that the time is now, and it is short. This is the time to repent because the world is passing. (1Cor7:31). This is a warning for everybody, whether rich or poor, leader or follower, beautiful or ugly, clergy or laity. *'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2024.'*

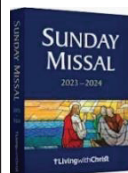
