## AGM Annual General Meeting



• **February 4th 11:30 PM to 1:30 PM in the Memorial Hall** - An AGM is an opportunity for the Pastor and his team, along with parish service groups, to report to the parish on their activities in the parish. And it is a chance for the pastoral team and service groups to share their vision for the parish and its future and to solicit input from the whole parish. **Come and be informed about the parish, its activities and ministries, its challenges and its hope - and have a chance to have your own say in the future of our parish.**

**Reflection:** In the first reading today, the Lord declares His position on the role of His prophet, one who speaks in his name. This is why he says "I will put my words into his mouth, and he shall tell them all I command him" (Deut 18:18). This is to say that to be a spokesperson of the Lord, one must be responsible, disciplined, forthright and courageous, so that when he receives the word, he goes straight to prophesy what the Lord wants prophesied. This prophetic mission is conferred on Christians at the time of baptism. Having been given this mandate, we are to be courageous, confident, fearless in carrying out the prophetic mission given to us by God through His Church. To borrow the words of Saint Paul in the second reading, as prophets of God, we are called to serve the Lord with undivided attention. *'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2024.'*
