RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

DESCRIPTION OF PROCESS:

This process prepares unbaptized adults for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). It also prepares those adults who have been baptized in another faith for full Communion with the Catholic Church.



SCHEDULE: Our parish will be partnering with Our Lady of Hope parish. Sessions will be held every Wednesday evening from 7:00 – 8:30 pm. 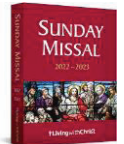

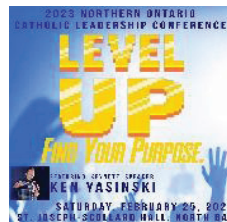

EXCITING NEW ADDITION TO POLAR PLUNGE

Bishop Thomas Dowd has agreed to join Father Raymond Akor and parishioner Chris Narozanski for a dunk in the icy waters of Sudbury's Ramsey Lake, if we can achieve \$50,000 in donations toward the plunge. We have already raised \$24,000 toward the plunge and continue to raise funds, but we need more of your assistance. Please dig deep and help us achieve our goal of having our Bishop join the plunge.

In the spirit of the 56th Annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, we have invited our diocesan brothers and sisters to view our Polar Plunge online. We have kindly asked that they donate to our plunge initiative to assist us in reaching the \$50,000 goal as set by the Bishop.

The plunge will take place on Saturday, February 25, 2023. Father Raymond and parishioner Chris will take the plunge into Ramsey Lake's icy waters at 1 p.m. **Again, Bishop Thomas Dowd's participation depends on your generosity.** The plunge will be recorded and shown in the warmth of Christ the King's Memorial Hall shortly thereafter.
