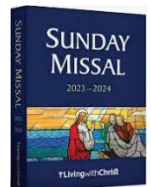

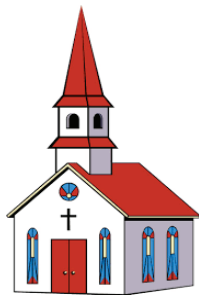

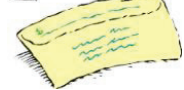


OUR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS – VIRTUE OF THE MONTH- January
