guidelines, wearing masks, and practicing physical distancing during Mass. We appreciate all that you are doing, and believe that we'll get through all of this together.

During last Sunday's Mass, Wanda Sutton and Andrew Kendall, our Volunteer Co-ordinators, addressed the congregation on behalf of our team. Here are the important reminders, they addressed:

As we continue our efforts to ensure the safe opening of Masses to parishioners of the Church of Christ the King we appreciate your patience, cooperation, and continued support. We would especially like to thank all of our volunteers, the parish leadership, and those in our faith community that continue to allow the opening of the parish to be possible. If you wish to volunteer, please consider calling the parish office and our volunteer team will get in touch with you.

Please note that public Masses are currently running on Wednesday (12:00PM noon), and Sunday (10:15AM). If you wish to attend Mass please register in advance by phoning the Parish office at (705) 674-6447. All Masses (Tuesday-Saturday at 12:00PM, and Sunday at 10:15AM continue to be livestreamed on **christthekinglive.com**). As we move forward we will continue to assess our capacity and capabilities in conjunction with our volunteer team in order to make decisions about opening the parish for additional public masses.

Please also be advised of these important notices regarding Mass attendance:

- Catholics are still dispensed from their obligation of Sunday Mass attendance at this time;
- COVID-19 is still a threat to public health and our parish is only open to a capacity of 47 people;
- Screening and public health protocols are in place – we ask that you check your temperature at home and wash your hands before coming to the church for Mass;
- All parishioners are expected to wear non-medical masks and should bring their own masks – we suggest that parishioners over the age of five wear masks during Mass;
- Some parishioners may not be allowed entry for a specific Mass if capacity is reached before their arrival, or they present symptoms during the screening questionnaire;
- Those who are considered vulnerable and those who care for them should not attend;
- There will be no children's liturgy at this time;
- Parishioners attending Masses should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to Mass, and note that doors will be closed 5 minutes prior to the scheduled beginning of Mass;



- Washrooms will be closed, so parishioners are reminded to be aware of this before attending Masses;
- Please respect social distancing protocols and floor/pew markings while in the church;
- Please follow the direction of the ushers before leaving your pew during communion and before exiting at the conclusion of Mass;

- When exiting the parish, we will be exiting starting from the back rows and moving forward. Please wait for the usher to direct you.
