Reflection: Jesus uses examples of what people are used to, especially from nature. In today's Gospel, He takes the example of a farmer who goes out to sow and the various results from different soil forms. A parable is a simple story that has deeper, heavenly meaning. Just as a plant can grow well on good soil, likewise will the word of God bear fruit in a good heart. Hence, a good disposition is necessary for a heart to bear fruit. Some harden their hearts and reject the Gospel at all costs. We must also nurture the faith we have received by taking care of the soil, weeding out where necessary, pruning the plants and trees, etc. This implies that we ought to prune our attitudes and behaviours and weed out what destroys and affects our relationship with God.

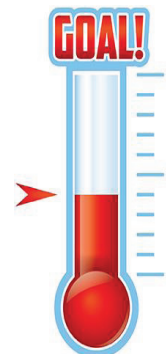

These Young Adults will participate in this holy pilgrimage of faith with youth from across the world, joined by Pope Francis. World Youth Day is a celebration of the Catholic faith held on an international scale every three years or so. Please keep our 13 Pilgrims in your prayers as they prepare for their journey to World Youth Day!

Fundraising Update Re: Front Stairs

The Christ the King Fundraising Committee has been working diligently to raise funds for the replacement of the front stairs of the church. Covid, inflation and the supply chain issues have all conspired to drastically increase the funds needed for the stair project. However, the committee is not deterred. Although, we are currently taking a summer break, this does not imply that nothing is going on. We are still charging ahead with new ideas! As of June 25, 2023 we have raised \$230,023 toward the new stairs. Once we reach \$300,000, the crumbling stairs will be removed and construction of the new stairs will begin. The final cost for the new stairs is expected to be approximately \$600,000. We must raise half of the final cost to get started. The diocese will then issue a loan for the remaining \$300,000. We are now within \$70,000 of our magic starting amount of \$300,000! The committee wishes to express our gratitude and thank you for your ongoing support.
