

Fundraising Update Re: Front Stairs

The Christ the King Fundraising Committee has been working diligently to raise funds for the replacement of the front stairs of the church. Covid, inflation and the supply chain issues have all conspired to drastically increase the funds needed for the stair project. However, the committee is not deterred. Although, we are currently taking a summer break, this does not imply that nothing is going on. We are still charging ahead with new ideas! As of June 25, 2023 we have raised \$230,023 toward the new stairs. Once we reach \$300,000, the crumbling stairs will be removed and construction of the new stairs will begin. The final cost for the new stairs is expected to be

approximately \$600,000. We must raise half of the final cost to get started. The diocese will then issue a loan for the remaining \$300,000. We are now within \$70,000 of our magic starting amount of \$300,000! The committee wishes to express our gratitude and thank you for your ongoing support.
