**Scing's Corner** Joseph Chiwatenhwa, recognized by the first Jesuit Missionaries to Huronia as one of the first Aboriginal converts and catechists, and remembered by Pope Saint John Paul II on his visit to Canada and to the Martyr's Shrine in Midland in 1984. The Pope is quoted saying "what great importance to the Church is Joseph Chiwatenhwa who together with his wife Aonetta, his brother and other family members lived and witnessed to their faith in a heroic manner." Joseph was inspired to write"...Jesus, you love us so deeply... I chose you as my chief. There is no one else." He was martyred on August 2<sup>nd</sup> 1640 at the age of 38
