Jesus asked his disciples to proclaim the Good News. We can share the Good News by telling others about what we heard at Mass today; teach others

about Jesus's love for us; and share news of Jesus' promise of eternal life.

Reflection: Today's liturgy shows us how God needs people in His work. The Gospel reveals that the ideal of Christian administrative leadership isn't the wielding power over others, as it is with some business people and politicians, but the use of power for others. It is not a political "might is right", but "might for right". It is a power to care, to share, and to heal. Jesus' heart was moved with pity for the crowds, a pity that went to the depths of his being. He sees in the crowd all the marginalized: the tired, the abused, the sad and the abandoned. They are "like sheep without a shepherd". The first petition of His prayer as an ideal leader is to ask the master of the harvest for laborers. Without prayer, leaders risk acting contrary to the will of Christ. The amount of work was way out of proportion to the resources. Like a teacher with students, or a president dispatching ambassadors, or a general with officers, Jesus calls and gives his new apostles instructions. They are to do as well as to teach: to cure the sick, raise the dead, seek the lost and show compassion for the flock, especially the abandoned. This is the vocation of every Christian. Our homes, parishes and workplaces offer us opportunities to fulfill all these duties. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2023.'




