
The Re-opening of the Parish ... A Message from our Parish Council ...



Members of Parish Council met Tuesday night to discuss opening the church for Masses. At this time, we are in *critical* need of volunteers to assist with screening, ushering people to their pews and sanitizing after Masses. We cannot open the church without your help. If you are interested and able to volunteer for Sunday or weekday Masses, please call the parish office as soon as possible at 705-674-6447.

If you are interested in volunteering, training for volunteers will take place this Friday, June 19, at 7 p.m., at the church (please enter by the ramp door).

The Re-opening of the Parish Office ... The Province has extended its emergency measure until June 30, 2020. Due to the pandemic, we have some new procedures in place when the office re-opens. All requests (booking a Mass, request for Mass cards, Sacramental certificates, etc), are to be made in advance by email or by telephone. The completed Mass card or certificate may then be picked up at the Rectory front door (white porch) at a mutually convenient time. Our parish office will be staffed next week with reduced hours, two days a week: Tuesday from 10 am – 2 pm, and Thursday from 10 am – 2 pm. This is a temporary measure. All visitors to the parish office will be asked to wear a mask, or protective face shield, and maintain physical distancing.

A Saint's Corner ... Influenced by Bishop Bourget, 20-year-old Louis Zepherin Moreau pursued his call despite health issues and disruptions in his studies at the seminary. He was born in 1824 to a farm family. Moreau was the fifth child and was not strong enough to help out on the farm. He did show inner strength and was sent to school and, after that, studied in the priesthood and became Father Moreau in 1846. He developed a deep love for prayer, Scripture and great devotion to the Eucharist and Mary. Later, he founded the Union of St. Joseph, a fraternity similar of today's Knights of Columbus, and was ordained Bishop in 1876. Theme: Who is Jesus Christ? Exploration of the 'I am' Sayings of Jesus Dates: August 17-21, 2020 Who is God? When Moses asked that question before the burning bush more than 3000 years ago, the mysterious response was "I AM". A millennium later, that strange name received a face, and that face began to teach. In the sixth chapter of John's Gospel, Jesus Christ, the Word made flesh, left a series of statements about his identity, known as the seven "I am" sayings. Enigmatic yet meaningful, they elaborate the identity, personality, and intention of the God-with-us. Drawing from the natural world and the Old Testament, the seven images offer a rich understanding of the nature of Jesus. I invite you to join me on Zoom for this five-day retreat. Together we will explore all seven of the "I am" sayings, with a daily 9 am conference, Eucharist at 2 pm and time for sharing at 7 pm. Personal direction can be offered through Skype. Following the arc of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius, the retreat will provide points for meditation, with the goal bringing about our deeper transformation in the light of Christ and into the embrace of our Creator.
