Fellow Parishioners:

The following is a Q & A for the front stair project. Why are you building such fancy, high end stairs that cost \$700.000?

Pre-pandemic, there were many ideas as to the design of the stairs but nothing was finalized. Many wanted flower gardens, statues etc. At that time, a ballpark guote of \$350,000 was given for the stair project. Then came the pandemic. Mid-pandemic a quote of \$700,000 was given for the project. More recently, \$600,000 was the estimated

As of now (June 2024), the final design is not yet reality although it has been scaled back. What is reality is that the stairs will be high quality and of similar design to the previous stairs as those served the parishioners well. There is a concrete shortage across Canada. As such, the concrete industry has supply chain disruptions. Demand is high and production is low due to raw material and labour shortages. These shortages started in 2022 and continue to this day. In Southern Ontario, the current cost of a private home concrete patio installation can average anywhere from \$20 to \$80 per square foot depending on design, size and finish. This means that a small concrete patio with a few steps can be \$10,000 to \$12,000. A medium patio with steps \$15,000-\$30,000 and a large concrete patio is \$30,0000+. With a bit of extrapolation, you can figure out the general cost of commercial grade, basic, safe stairs for our church. This is no small project.

Why is it taking so long to start the new stairs?

Even though we hope the stairs will come in below the \$600,000 mark, we must work with the last estimate of \$600,000 for the new stairs. According to Diocese policy, we must raise half of the needed funds for a capital project before it can be started, in this case, \$300,000. We are now at just over \$280,000. We are almost there!

It is quite an accomplishment!

The fundraising team is doing their best to raise funds for the front stairs. Considering the fact that they have been able to raise +\$280,000 in a little over 2 years is quite a commendable accomplishment. This would have not been possible without the assistance of all the parishioners and we appreciate your continued support. Thank you for your consistent dedication to this parish community!
