WELCOME BACK:

We are so happy to start our celebrations with our parishioners, in person. As CoVid-19 is still a threat to public health, our churches are open at 30% capacity. *Please do not enter the church if you have a fever, feel ill, or have been in contact with a CoVid-19 positive person over the past two weeks*. The Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie, and our parish, want to make sure that we re-open safely, according to public health guidelines, and so some necessary precautions are to be temporarily enacted:

- Dispensation from Obligation Catholics are still dispensed from their obligations of Sunday Mass attendance at this time.
- Seating Capacity is at 30%. Certain pews have been blocked to help with physical distancing. Members of the same household may sit together. Once we have reached 30% capacity, latecomers will be invited to attend the next Mass.
- Masks All who enter the church must wear a mask. Please bring your own.
- Children's Liturgy will not take place during this time.
- Reception of Communion will be accepted by hand only, not by the tongue, for the time being. Please follow the directions of the volunteer coordinators/ushers who will direct one row at a time. Please remain in pews until ushered out for Communion.
- Music no congregational singing at this time. Our Director of Music will play simple musical pieces. The Parish choir will not resume until further notice.
- Love one another.

 Stay socially distant but spiritually close.
- Collection there will be no presentation of gifts. Collection baskets will be provided at the exit door.
 Parishioners will still be encouraged to drop off collections at the Rectory door mail slot (white porch) or by mail.
- Departure at the end of Mass please follow the directions of our usher team who will invite your departure by pew. Parishioners are asked to maintain physical distance and to not congregate at the doors of the church.
- Cleaning after each Mass, the church will be locked so that it may be cleaned for the next Mass.
- Lay pastoral care ministers are not permitted at this time to bring communion to shut-ins and health care facilities. All requests must be forwarded to the parish priest.
- Parish Ministries all parish ministries, meetings, and social gatherings are on hold. A memo regarding the resumption of parish activities will be sent out at the appropriate time.

We are taking precautions to protect the health and safety of everyone who comes into the church. However, there can be no guarantees of complete protection from infection, there will always be risks of contracting the viral infections in large gatherings of people. If you develop CoVid-19 symptoms in the days following your attendance at Mass, please phone or email the parish office, in addition to contacting your doctor and public health unit.

As we adjust to the re-opening of our parish, all of Christ the King's Masses will continue to be viewed on-line. The following two Masses are open for attendance (at 30% capacity):

Sunday Eucharist 10:15 am (church Main doors open at 9:45 am) and Wednesday, 12:05 pm Mass (church door – side ramp - open at 11:15 am for Adoration)

We ask that you kindly follow the directions of our volunteer ushers and clergy. If you are sick with a cold or flu, please stay home to rest and recover. If you are ill or if you are hesitant about coming back to church at this time, please note that all Catholics in our Diocese are dispensed from the Obligation to attend Mass until further notice.

Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) and Eucharist: Please call the parish office (calls are being monitored at 705-674-6447) to make an appointment to see Fr. Raymond for the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) and/or to receive the Holy Eucharist.


July 1 is celebrated as Canada's birthday. Canadians should seek to be witnesses to
