- 1. Enter into the Reconciliation Room, and either kneeling behind the screen or sitting in front of the priest, begin with the Sign of the Cross.
- Then say, "Bless me Father for I have sinned, it has been \_\_\_\_ months since my last Confession, these are my sins...
- Briefly tell the priest your sins, and he will then counsel you, giving you a helpful penance.
- You will then be asked to say an "Act of Contrition".
- The priest will then extend his hand over your head and pray over you the "Prayer of Absolution".
- The priest will then say, "You may go in peace". You may respond in saying, "Thank you".
