

Jesus knew that his life on earth would soon end. He tried to prepare his disciples for His death and

resurrection by speaking about a seed that must die before new life can happen. Pray with our children in gratitude for the gift of a new life in Heaven when our life on earth is complete.

Reflection: As we approach Holy Week, the themes of suffering, surrender and dying are repeated. The prayer in today's gospel passage is known as the "Gethsemane prayer" of John's gospel. In that prayer, Jesus himself was "troubled" by the reality of suffering that he had to endure. But he understood the mystery of the wheat grain and was ready to surrender to the Father. To our way of seeing things, pain and suffering are not only an utter waste; the suffering of the innocent is a great scandal. We look for painless ways of being fruitful. Yet, Jesus asserts: "if it dies, it bears much fruit". Jesus did not go in search of suffering. But when love and fidelity and one's mission involve the cross, one has to let go of all the we cling to: our love of life. What appears to be failure, loss and extinction, will bear fruit in unimaginable

ways. Like Christ, we will become a source of life for others. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2024.
