Reflection: A summary of human life can be experienced if one were to accompany Jesus from Palm Sunday to Easter. On Palm Sunday, Jesus is apparently at the height of his popularity after having received a rousing welcome because of his fame as a wonder-working teacher. As we enter into Holy Week, everything changes to betrayal, torture and death. The admiring throng and the hosannas are things of the past. Even being a participant in the Last

Supper does not prevent one from betraying Jesus. The man dying on the cross like a common criminal does not in any way appear like the Messiah who was acclaimed a few days earlier. How did Jesus Go Through this ordeal? In his most trying moments of crisis, he turns first, not for human consolation, but to God. Jesus's story can be our story. What we contemplate today and this week is a graphic and realistic account of what every human life is. Finally, victory is ours! *'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2024'*
