Irish Soda Oat Bread Recipe:

In Large bowl mix:	In another bowl mix	
1 c. of rolled oats	3 c. of whole wheat flour	
¼ c. molasses	1 c. of all-purpose flour	
2 c. of buttermilk	1 ½ tsp soda	
Mix well	½ tsp salt	
	1 tsp of cream of tarter	

Mix well.

Mix together into the large bowl. If a little dry add ¼ c. of water. Work into 2 balls and kneed into 2 round loafs. Wrap in plastic, let stand at room temperature overnight. Bake in pre-heated oven @ 400 F for 15 minutes, then @ 350F for 20 minutes. Let cool on rack. Enjoy 🛛
