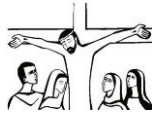

Paschal Fast... Good Friday is a day of *Paschal Fast* to honour the suffering and death of the Lord and to help us prepare to share more deeply in the joy of the resurrection. Catholics are to abstain from meat and those between the ages of 14 – 59 are encouraged to fast between meals.



We might also consider eating more moderately during this time. In this way, the people of God will receive the joys of the Lord's resurrection with uplifted and responsive hearts (ORDO: 169).



Development & Peace... wishes to thank all those who donated or will donate in the Share Lent campaign. 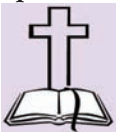
