May is the month of traditional devotion to Mary, the Mother of God; Queen of Heaven and Earth.


A Prayer for Mothers... Loving God,

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) ~ The RCIA process will begin in our parish in the fall. It's not too early to begin discerning the call to become a member of the Catholic Church. The RCIA is

intended for adults who have not been baptized. We also accept individuals who have been baptized in other Christian churches as well as baptized Catholics who have not yet celebrated Confirmation or received their First Communion. As a group, we will meet weekly beginning in the fall and concluding with the Feast of Pentecost [end of the Easter Season] in 2016. If you, or someone you know, would like to become a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church, please contact Fr. Brian, Deacon Roland Muzzatti, or the parish office. Parishioners will be welcome to attend the RCIA sessions as a way of updating their understanding of the Catholic faith. Their participation is also a great support to the individuals who are discerning the Lord's call to the Catholic Church. The Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist – are celebrated during the Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday) and during the Easter Season.
