Reflection:

At the Last Supper, Jesus promises the coming of the Holy Spirit. He tells His disciples: "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Paraclete to be with you forever, [namely] the Spirit of truth (Jn 14:16-17) Jesus refers to the Holy Spirit as "Paraclete". The word "Paraclete" was used to refer to one's advocate/lawyer, comforter or counsellor. Firstly, as our Advocate, the Spirit is on our side and speaks on our behalf in prayers (cf. Rom 8:27). Secondly, as a lawyer would do for a discouraged client (accused of a serious crime), so the Spirit comforts us and gives us the grace to persevere in difficult times. Thirdly, as a lawyer might counsel his/her client (on what to say at a court hearing), so the Spirit counsels us in many ways (cf. Lk 12:11-12; Acts 15:28). Let us seek a personal relationship with the Holy Spirit. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2023.'






