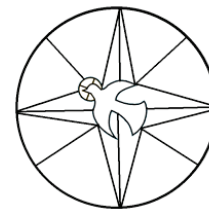

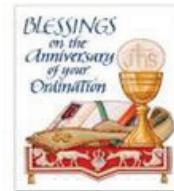
MASS INTENTIONS

The Apostolic Nuncio to Canada has informed the CCCB General Secretariat that the date for the Collection for the Pastoral Works of the Holy Father (Peter’s Pence Collection) has been **postponed until the fall**. Due to the pandemic and the closure of churches to the general public, the Holy See has decided to postpone the prescribed annual collection for the 2020 Pope’s Pastoral Works to the **4th of October 2020**, Memorial of St. Francis of Assisi.
