#### **SAINTS' CORNER**

Blessed Louis-Zephirin Moreau... Born in 1824, in Quebec among 13 siblings, educated in a seminary but held back from priesthood because of health problems. His persistence and desire led to his ordination in 1846. Appointed to secretary in the diocese of Montreal and later for the diocese of Saint-Hyacinthe. In 1875, he became bishop, and it was his compassion for the poor working people and his involvement in establishing the forerunners of today's credit unions that he became well known as "the good Bishop Moreau". He was beatified in 1987 Source: Canadian Biography – University of Toronto/Laval.


