**Reflection:** The seed of faith planted by Christ, through His Paschal Mystery, in the hearts of



His disciples gathered in the Cenacle, is today watered by the 'fire' of the Holy Spirit, and immediately grows and bears a rich harvest, almost instantly. The disciples who, just a few minutes earlier, were shrouded in fear and prayed in secret, were suddenly made bold and fearless, and armed with the power of the Holy Spirit, they went out to preach in a miraculous way, by speaking in tongues strange to them, but familiar to their listeners. Indeed today, we celebrate the fulfilment of promise of Jesus not to leave us orphaned. We are not alone, we have never been alone, because the Church resided in the heart of the Trinity, and the Trinity works in the heart of all God's children. *Without Pentecost the Christ-event: the life death and resurrection of Jesus, remains imprisoned in history as something to remember, think about and reflect on. The spirit of Jesus comes to dwell within us, so that we can become living Christs here and now.*

## Update!!

**From Christ the King Fundraising team:**

Our one-time fundraisers such as the Polar Plunge, Porketta Bingo and the Penne Pasta Dinner are used to fund special projects like the front stairs. This project is the main capital project. The cost is in the \$600,000 range but with cost cutting measures, perhaps less. You will notice that the east and west side of the stairs closest to the church have been dug out. **This is the start.** We are just shy of \$280,000 to put toward the stair project. At \$300,000, we will have raised half of the cost. At that time, we are permitted to go full steam ahead! We are currently making decisions related to our next fundraisers. We thank you for supporting our fundraising efforts and look forward to seeing you at our next event!
