From Christ the King Fundraising team:

Our one-time fundraisers such as the Polar Plunge, Porketta Bingo and the Penne Pasta Dinner are used to fund special projects like the front stairs. This project is the main capital project. The cost is in the \$600,000 range but with cost cutting measures, perhaps less. You will notice that the east and west side of the stairs closest to the church have been dug out. This is the start. We are just shy of \$280,000 to put toward the stair project. At \$300,000, we will have raised half of the cost. At that time, we are permitted to go full steam ahead! We are currently making decisions related to our next fundraisers. We thank you for supporting our fundraising efforts and look forward to seeing you at our next event!

Our Memorial Wall is expanding with new plaques. We continue to take orders for plaques as a lasting memory of family and friends. The money raised goes directly to our front stair project.


