Faith - Service - Social Justice

Reflection: Among the Manifestations on the first Christian Pentecost Day, there are "tongues of fire". It is the medium by which the Holy Spirit fills the disciples (cf. Acts 2:3-4). Firstly, fire is used to purify metals. Likewise, the Holy spirit cleanses us of our sins (cf. Acts 2:37-38). Secondly, as fire destroys things, so the Holy Spirit destroys evil (cf. Acts 13:6-12). Thirdly, the human tongue signifies speech. So the appearance of the Holy Spirit in the form of tongues means that He is the One who



enables us to proclaim the good news. For instance, Peter, who becomes timid from the moment of Jesus' arrest, becomes not only courageous enough to stand before thousands of people but also eloquent (cf. Acts 2:14-41). Let us therefore pray that the fire of the Holy Spirit might set us a flame to boldly and eloquently proclaim the Good News of Salvation. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2023.'
