

Weekend Masses - Entrance/Exit Doors Update Beginning June 4, we will be using the wooden door closest to the Sacristy as the main entrance for parishioners arriving from the Christ the King Centre parking lot. The basement's glass doors will be locked and signage will be placed to indicate the wooden door entrance. Parishioners will continue to be able to access basement washrooms and the Memorial Hall from inside the Parish.

There is no change to the ramp entrance.

All doors will be unlocked a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the beginning of Weekend Masses (4:30PM on Saturdays, 9:45AM on Sundays).
