

Every spring in April and May our liturgy is enriched with feast days of Canadian saintly women. In April we remember *St. Kateri Tekakwitha, St. Marie of the Incarnation* and *Blessed Marie-Anne Blondin*. The whole month of May is dedicated to our Heavenly Mother Mary all around the world and here at home she is joined by two ladies we remember from the early days of the Canadian Church. They are *Blessed Marie-Leonie Paradis* and *Catharine of St. Augustine*. Four of these women dedicated their lives to God and the Church in the ministries of Health and Education. St. Kateri represents not only our Aboriginal heritage in Christianity but also the Love for Jesus in piety and



suffering. Beside these five women there are also two Bishops, *Saint Francois de Laval*, first Bishop in Quebec, and *Blessed Louis-Zephirin Moreau*, the "Good Bishop Moreau".
