The Canadian Bishops, francophone sector, have decided that, as of December 2nd, a new French version of the "Our Father" (Notre Père) will be used in all forms of French public liturgy. I am informing you so that if ever you or your parishioners participate in a bilingual or French prayer service, you will be able to follow. Only one sentence will change, as I highlight here:

*Notre Père qui es au cieus,
que ton nom soit sanctifié,
que ton règne vienne,
que ta volonté soit faite sur la terre comme aux ciel.
Donne nous aujourd'hui notre pain de ce jour.
Pardonne-nous nos offenses comme nous pardonnons aussi à ceux qui nous ont offensés.
Ne nous laisse pas entrer en tentation, mais délivre-nous du mal. AMEN*
