



TODAY WE MAKE HISTORY!

As taken from the 60th Anniversary book of Church of Christ the King, Msgr Crowley was quoted saying "St. Anne's was the only Roman Catholic church in Sudbury at the time. The Jesuits had a parish hall called "Jubilee Hall" opposite St. Anne's and it was given to the new parish. I fixed up the ground floor as a chapel, seating about three hundred. It was still being used when I left for Sault Ste. Marie in 1920. I had just begun to build the rectory but the church was started by my successor, Rev. T. H. Trainor". In the spring of 1917 the parish of St. Joseph was

inaugurated to serve the growing congregation of English-speaking parishioners in Sudbury.



HISTORY MOMENTSNov. 26 - 27 Eglise Ste. Anne des Pins was started in 1883 by the building of the Rectory at its present site. It was used as a school and a church at that time. On September 16, 1904, the Holy See separated the Diocese of Sault Ste Marie from the Diocese of Peterborough. Bishop David Scollard was appointed as the first Bishop of the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie. Thirteen years later St. Joseph's Parish was inaugurated.


