SAINTS' CORNER...

Born in 1701 to an old and important family in New France, **Saint Marguerite d'Youville** is the foundress of the Grey Nuns and the first Canadian born Saint from Varennes, Quebec. Educated by the Ursulines, married in 1722 and widowed eight years later with two children and expecting. Overcoming enormous financial difficulties she embarked on a religious life for the rest of her life. With three companions she rented a house and looked after the sick and destitute; after many years of opposition from relatives and authorities she and her group, under Bishop Pontbriand (1755), were finally recognized as an Order.
