A Saint's Corner. Blessed Pope John Paul I, beatified in a beautiful Mass in Rome on September 4th. Some of us older Catholics will remember the year 1978, the year of three Popes in an era of great changes in our Church. Pope Saint Paul VI died in early August and Cardinal *Albino Luciani* became Pope John Paul I on the 26th, thirty-three days later he died in his sleep unexpectedly. He had no time at all to make an impact in the Vatican and world but he is well known for his smile, was called "Papa Luciani" and his successor Pope Saint John Paul II found him to be a warm, welcoming and friendly person. As a Bishop he was part of Vatican II and he also took part in the 1971 Synod of Bishops in Rome.
