Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

DESCRIPTION OF PROCESS: This process prepares adults for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). It also prepares those adults who have been baptized in another faith for full Communion with the Catholic Church. Finally, it is an excellent opportunity for Catholics who want to update their understanding of the Church's teachings. **SCHEDULE:** Sessions will be held every 2nd Wednesday evening from 7:00–8:30pm beginning on November 6 and ending on April 1. There are also periodic liturgical celebrations held at the regular Sunday Mass. **If anyone is interested in participating in this journey of faith, please register with the parish office by Tuesday, October 29th.**

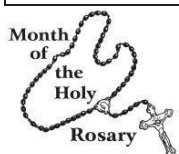
